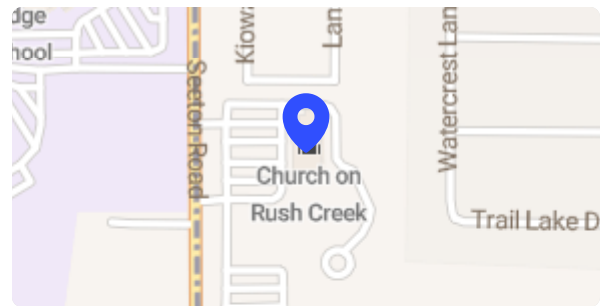

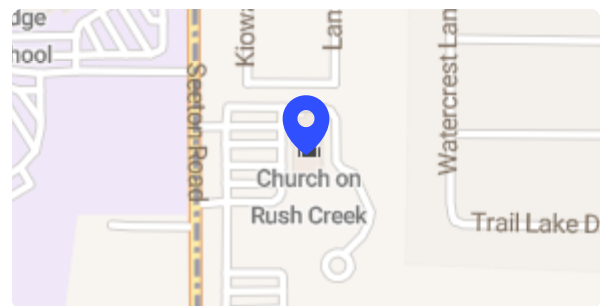

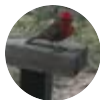


Janet Ellis lit a candle in honor of Vickie.
