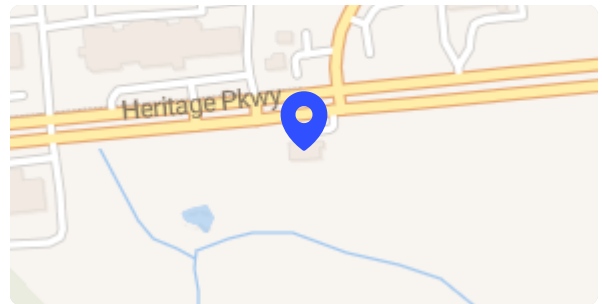

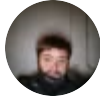




Tribute Wall
