Rudolph Alexander McCallum Sr., 72, passed away peacefully on Monday, November 4, 2019 in Arlington, Texas.

Rudolph, or 'Big Rudy' as he was affectionately known, was born July 16, 1947 in New York City to Lionel and Earthalee (Brown) McCallum. He graduated from Theodore Roosevelt High School in 1965.
