# Mark Tracy Hornbuckle

At an early age, Mark accepted Christ as His Savior and was baptized at Castleberry Baptist Church. He received his formal education in the Fort Worth Independent School District and graduated from Paul Laurence Dunbar High School in 1978.

Mark Tracy began his 37 year career at Harris Hospital in the Housekeeping Department. 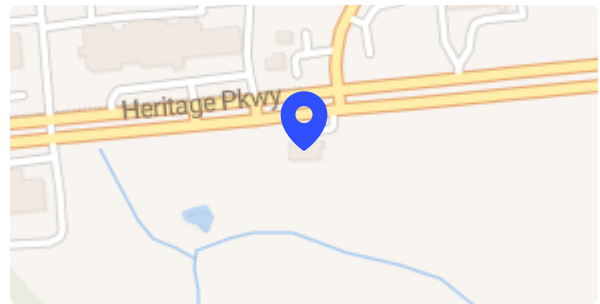

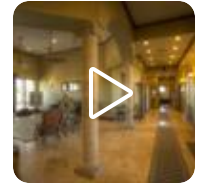

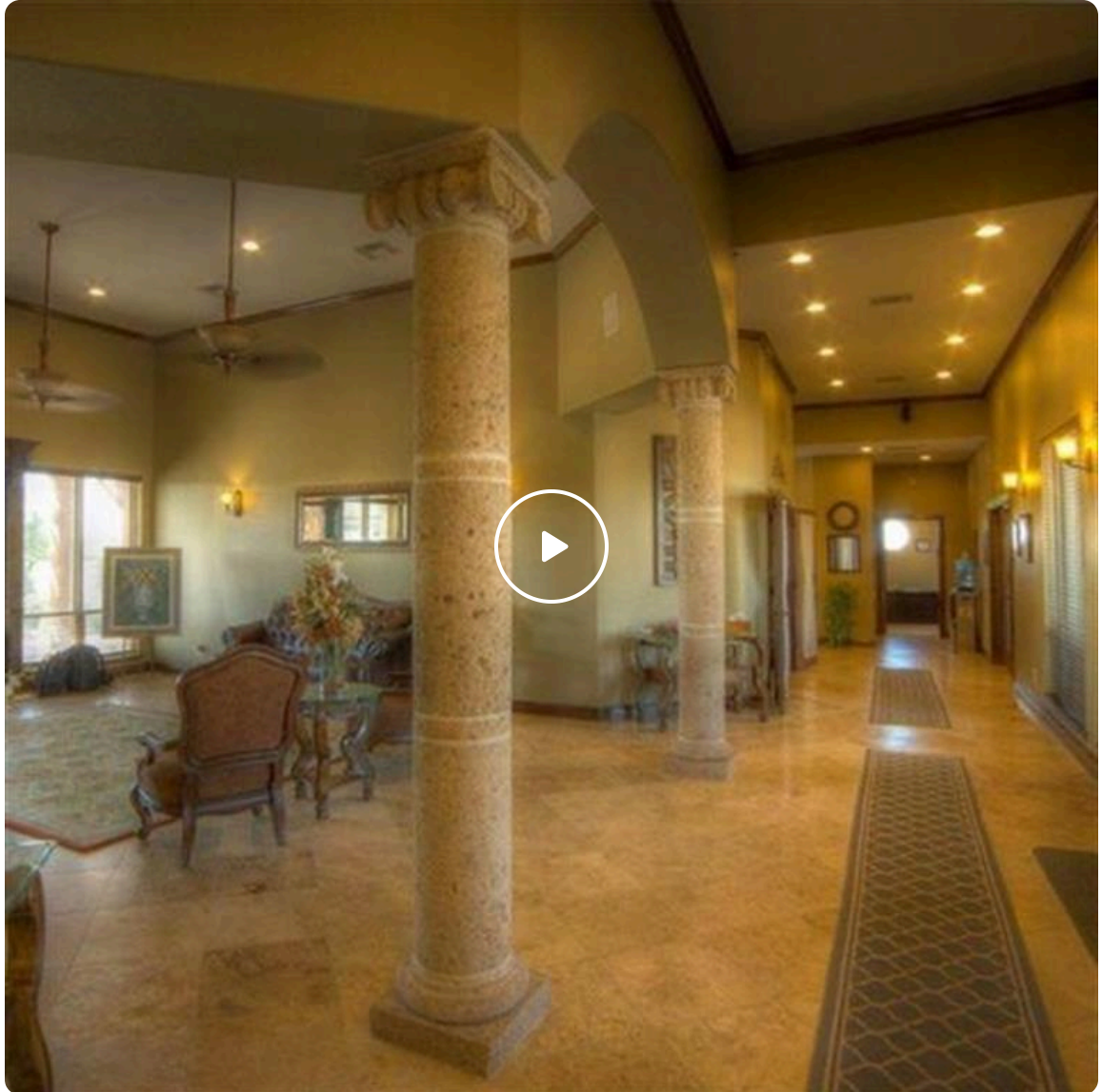
