On September 9, 1985, in Homestead, Florida, a beautiful baby girl was born to Charles and Doris Clay. They named her Rebecca Maria Clay, but the name Maria was changed to Marie by one of the hospital officials. She grew into a sweet little girl with a winning personality.

Rebecca, commonly called “Becky” attended Miami Heights Elementary. She was able to learn quickly and won several oratorical contest at school, beginning in Kindergarten. In high school, she took an interest in Law and began college with this in mind. She later changed her mind to Business and completed her Associate Degree in Business.

She moved to Texas and met Clifton Rodgers, who became the love of her life. They were united in marriage on August 1, 2009, and to this union three children were born: one son, Preston Bernard Rodgers, who preceded her in death, and two daughters Claire Ann, and Zoey Lynn Parker Rodgers.

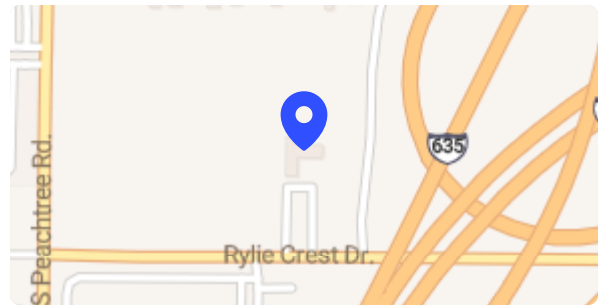

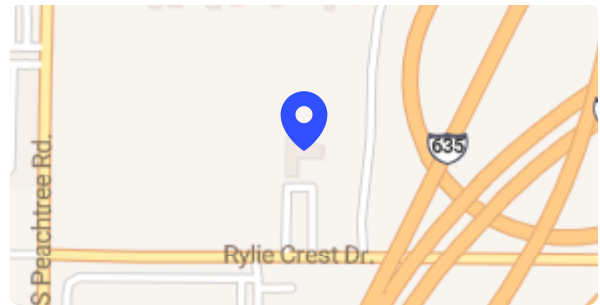

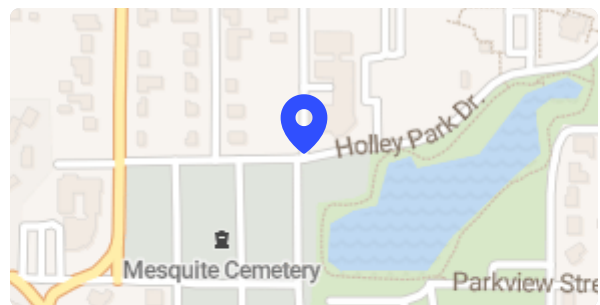
