Her family is appreciative for all of the love and prayers that were sent their way.



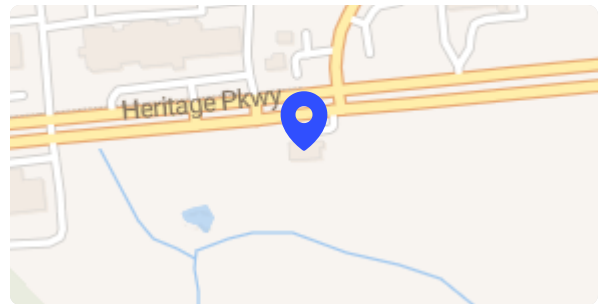

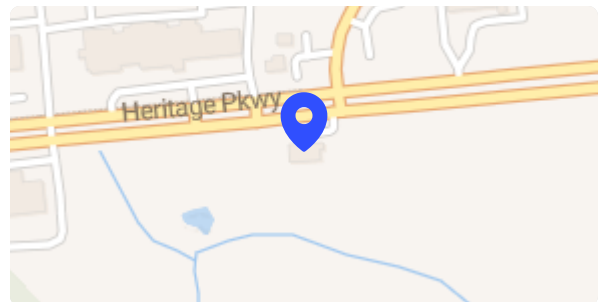

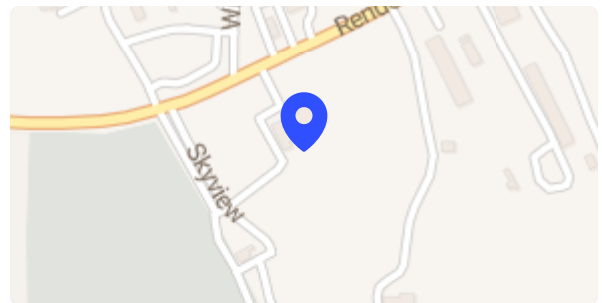
